Studies: Bachelor of Philosophy (1995), Master of Philosophy (1996), Bachelor of Classical Philology (1997) at „Babeş-Bolyai” University of Cluj-Napoca, PhD in Philosophy (2000) at the University of Bucharest, Habilitation at "Al. I. Cuza" University of Iaşi (2013)

Professional position: Full university professor, director of the Department of Premodern and Romanian Philosophy. Between 2008 and 2012 I was Chancellor of the Faculty of History and Philosophy of “Babeş-Bolyai” University, Cluj-Napoca. Since 2016 I am vice-president of the Scientific Council of “Babeş-Bolyai” University, Cluj-Napoca.

Specialisations: In 1999 I was awarded a research scholarship at the University of Geneva, as part of the collaboration agreement between this university and “Babeş-Bolyai”, where I had Prof. Alain de Libera as my coordinating professor. In the academic year 2000-2001 I was a scholar of “New Europe College” in Bucharest. In the academic year 2003-2004 I was a scholar of the Association of Universities of the Francophonie (AUF), at Ecole de Hautes Etudes en Sciences Sociales, Paris, following the invitation of Prof. Alain Boureau. In 2013 I was invited for a month of studies and conferences at the Academy of Sciences of the Czech Republic in Prague and in 2014 for a month of studies and conferences at "Albertus Magnus Institut" in Bonn.

Publications: I have published **8 volumes of exegesis** on medieval philosophy, **18 volumes with editions** of treaties of ancient and medieval philosophy, with commentaries and critical apparatus, **65 academic studies** in professional journals or collective volumes, other articles, reviews and translations from Greek and Latin authors in separate volumes and journals, as mentioned in the bibliographical list.

Foreign languages: French, English, Latin, Ancient Greek, and Hungarian.

Editorial boards: I am currently leading the collection “Surse clasice” (“Classical Sources”) at Humanitas Publishing House in Bucharest, the collections “Cogito” and “Filosofie medievală” (“Medieval Philosophy”) at Univers Enciclopedic in Bucharest, and at Polirom Publisher in Iași the collection “Biblioteca medievală” (“The Medieval Library”), which support the development of studies and translations of ancient and medieval philosophy into Romanian. I am an editor at “Chora-Revue des Etudes Anciennes et Medievales”, which is issued in Iași, a referent in the editorial board of the magazine “Analele Universității din Timișoara”, a referent in the editorial board of the collection “Neoplatonism” of the Zeta Books Publisher, a referent in the editorial board of “Analele Universității Ștefan cel Mare” from Suceava, of the “Analele Universității Creștine ‘Dimitrie Cantemir’. History Series – New Series”, scientific referent for philosophy of Polirom Publisher, since April 2010.
